Tropical (Annual) Info Sheet

Tropical Hibiscus Shrub/Tree

- -Upright, dense bushy shrub
- -Large, showy papery flowers. Attracts butterflies.
- -Plant in full sun. Needs extra attention and water in very warm climates and temperatures.
- -Fertilize with Miracle-Gro Bloom Booster (water soluble fertilizer)
- -It is a tropical annual, so it will have to be brought inside for the winter season. Any temperatures below 34 degrees the plant will freeze.

Tropical Gardenia

- -Needs acidic, evenly moist soils with excellent drainage and fertility are crucial for plant health and successful blooming. Do not overwater.
- -Fertilize with Miracle-Gro Bloom Booster (water soluble fertilizer)
- -Grows best in full to partial sun and should be provided with good air circulation (prefers shade in the hot afternoon)
- -Produces large fragrant double flowers
- -Glossy green leaves

Tropical Duranta

- -Large, heavy flowering plant. Prefers moist, well drained soil.
- -Fertilize with Miracle-Gro Bloom Booster (water soluble fertilizer)
- -Grows best in full to partial sun and should be provided with good air circulation (prefers shade in the hot afternoon)
- -Produces large fragrant flowers
- -Be careful in high winds, can be top heavy

Tropical Mandevilla

- -Fast growing, heavy blooming vine.
- -Prefers moist, well drained soil.
- -Fertilize with Miracle-Gro Bloom Booster (water soluble fertilizer)
- -Grows best in full sun
- -Vine types need a trellis to climb onto; shrub types can be planted in a container
