MAGNOLIA SCALE <i>Affects Magnolias</i>	Bayer Tree & Shrub Insect Control (April) Bonide Insecticidal Soap (April-June) Bonide Horticultural Oil (December-February)	 <p>Magnolia Scale</p>
OYSTERSHELL SCALE <i>Affects Maples, Dogwoods, and many other trees & shrubs</i>	Bayer Tree & Shrub Insect Control (April-May or September-October)	
LEAF MINER <i>Affects Birch, Hawthorn, & Maple</i>	Bayer Tree & Shrub Insect Control (April-May or September-October)	
AERIFIED MITE <i>Affects Maple, Elm, Pear & Honeylocust</i>	Bayer Tree & Shrub Insect Control (April-May or September-October)	
APHIDS <i>Affects many tree, shrubs & perennials</i>	Bonide Insecticidal Soap (when insects are present April-September)	
BLACK (leaf) SPOT <i>Affects Roses, Pear, & Dogwood</i>	Bayer Disease Control (Spray every 3 weeks April-September) *always clear fallen leaves at the end of the season	
ROSE ROSSETTE DISEASE <i>Affects most shrub roses</i>	Bayer 3 in 1 Rose & Flower Care (April-September)
