



You are not just a parent at a school, you have joined a living community. If you are invested in building a community that nurtures children and your family, then you have arrived in the perfect place.

All families are asked to commit to the school in three ways:

- 1- Make a financial contribution. We intend to provide the equivalent of a private Waldorf education in a public school setting. To make this fully possible, we ask parents to help make up the difference. Evenly distributed, this cost is \$2,568 annually or only \$214 a month per child. Any, consistent contribution helps to pave the way to fully realizing this goal.
2- Be a participatory volunteer. We require 30 hours per child each year from each family in order to support the level of programming and service we provide.
3- Bring Waldorf home. Our method of teaching is effective when it is supported by families in their home lives. To really help your child - Spend time outdoors in unstructured activities, limit media (eliminate all violent, sexualized, and consumer-based programming), introduce rhythm in your home life, learn about simplicity parenting and positive discipline, eat and sleep well.
